Japanese maple, Trident maple, Amur maple, Field maple and Montpellier maple are popular choices and respond well to techniques that encourage leaf reduction and ramification, but most species can be used. Sugar, Black, and Red maple trees are tapped for sap, which is then boiled to produce maple syrup or made into maple sugar or maple taffy. It takes about 40 litres (42 US qt) of sugar maple sap to make 1 litre (1.1 US qt) of syrup.

Small, grey leaf buds grow on long stems. Field maples can grow to 20m and live for up to 350 years. Look out for: new seeds which are tinged with pink and the wings on the seeds set in a straight line. Identified in winter by: the older twigs which have corky ridges and small, grey leaf buds.

The leaves of deciduous trees change color through the seasons before they are shed in the fall. In spring, the first leaf buds appear. In summer the tree is thick with green leaves. A substance called chlorophyll colors the leaves green and helps the plant make food. During fall and winter, it is darker and the trees can't make as much food.

The sugar maple tree may grow to a height of 40 metres (130 feet). It has a dense crown of leaves, which turn various shades of gold to scarlet in fall. Its three- to five-lobed leaves appear after the greenish yellow flowers of spring. The fruits are paired samaras. Smooth grayish bark on the trunk and branches gradually furrows with age.
