Legislation or laws are made so that everyone in society knows which behaviours are acceptable and which are not.

The CARE CERTIFICATE Health and Safety
12(1) Care and treatment must be provided in a safe way for service users. Providers must provide care and treatment in a safe way. In particular, this includes the areas listed in 12(2) (a) – (i). However, 12(2) is not exhaustive and providers must demonstrate that they have done everything reasonably practicable to provide safe care and treatment.
